Forensic Psychiatry Background

I have testified in court in a variety of cases for the claimant or the defendant. The cases have been varied from minor personal issues to murder cases; from minor financial situations to those involved in major financial litigations. My testimony has been in Probate Courts, District Courts, State Courts, Federal Court, and Social Security Administrative Hearings. This testimony has been as an expert witness, or as the attending psychiatrist.

My clinical experience has been wide and varied. For example, State Psychiatric Hospitals, City Psychiatric Hospitals, State Hospital for the Criminally Insane, Detroit House of Correction, Psychiatric Clinic for paroled prisoners, Veterans Administration Psychiatric Clinic, Delinquency Prevention Project (joint program of Detroit Public Schools, Detroit Commission on Children and Youth, and Wayne State University School of Medicine) [Chief Psychiatric Director], psychiatric consultant International Center for Urban Studies.

In many states and countries, and in a variety of venues, I have lectured and presented papers to high school, college, and medical school students; as well as postgraduate physicians (in a variety of specialties, including psychiatry) on subjects that have included forensic issues.

I establish the Impaired Physician Program for the State of Michigan with the aid of two colleagues. As a result we rewrote the basic licensing and investigating procedure for physicians in the state. This was based on my work on the Michigan Psychiatric Society Ethics Committee (Chairman) and the Committee for Impaired Psychiatrists (Chairman). Similar work was done in founding the same programs for the Oakland County Medical Society.

I have also done peer review work for many years for the Michigan Peer Review Organization (MPRO), Michigan Psychiatric Society, Oakland County Medical Society, and the American Arbitration Association.
